



2010 California Payroll Tax Changes

There are changes in the payroll tax rates and wage limits for the California tax tables. These changes are effective **January 1st, 2010**. (You may access this information online at the Compusource web site at the following address: www.compusource.com.)

These changes should be made **AFTER** the final payroll of 2009 has been run, **AFTER** the "Save Year-end Info and Reset" program has been run, but **BEFORE** the first payroll run of 2010 is begun.

Do NOT change your tax tables with year-2010 rates until you have completed the "Save Year- end Info and Reset" for 2009: the system saves some of the 2009 tax rate information along with the 2009 employee data for later use by the W2 programs.

*** If you change your tax tables before you run the "Save Info and Reset" option, you will save year-2010 tax rates with year-2009 employee data and your W2 forms **won't print the correct amounts**.*

Use the "**State/Federal Tax Tables**" option in your Payroll system to make the table changes. (Note: on some systems, the option is called "Tax Parameter File Maintenance".)

Overview

Decrease in the State of California Standard Deduction

The standard deduction for the State of California for 2010 decreases to \$3,637 for Single, and \$7,274 for Married/Head of Household. You can update these fields yourself on the Custom Screen (option "U") of the "CA" (California) record of the Tax Data File--see the sample screen that follows. (Reference: "2010 California Employer's Guide", DE44MM Rev36, Table 3, p63.)

Increase in the State of California Bonus Pay Withholding Rate

The bonus pay withholding rate for the State of California for 2010 increases to 6.6% (0.0660). You can update this field yourself on the Data Screen (option "T") of the "CA" (California) record of the Tax Data File. Change the "BONUS PAY W/H RATE" of the "CA" (California) record of the Tax Data File to 0.0660.--see the sample screen that follows. (Reference: "2010 California Employer's Guide", DE44MM Rev36, p14.)

Decrease in the State of California Low Income Exemption

The low income exemption for the State of California for 2010 decreases to \$11,130 for Single, and \$22,261 for Married/Head of Household. You can update these fields yourself on the Custom Screen (option "U") of the "CA" (California) record of the Tax Data File--see the sample screen that follows. (Reference: "2010 California Employer's Guide", DE44MM Rev36, Table 1, p62.)

Decrease in the State of California Personal Exemption Credit

The personal exemption credit for the State of California for 2010 decreases to \$108 per allowance. You can update these fields yourself on the Custom Screen (option "U") of the "CA" (California) record of the Tax Data File. (Reference: "2010 California Employer's Guide", DE44MM, Table 4, p63.)

No Change in the State of California Unemployment Wage Limit

The California Unemployment wage limit for 2010 remains unchanged at \$7,000. The California Unemployment Contribution rate, however, varies from company to company, from 1.5% to 6.2%. The Employment Training Tax rate for 2010 remains at 0.1%. **Refer to your Form DE-2088 that you receive from the State of California Employment Development Department (EDD) for your contribution rates for Unemployment Insurance and Employment Training Tax.** Add these two rates together, and enter the sum as a decimal number for the employer unemployment rate. For example, if your DE-2088 indicates an Unemployment Contribution rate of 3.1% and an Employment Training Tax (ETT) rate of 0.1%, the total rate would be 3.2% or .03200 expressed as a decimal. Keep the "UNEMPLOYMENT TAX WAGE LIMIT" of the "CA" (California) record of the Tax Data File as 7000.00; the "UNEMPLOYMENT EMPLOYEE TAX RATE" is 0.00000, and the "UNEMPLOYMENT EMPLOYER TAX RATE" would be 0.03200, in the example I've just described--but your rate will probably be different. (If you have any questions on what your Unemployment rates should be, you can contact EDD Taxpayer Assistance Center at 888.745.3886.)

Increase in the State of California Disability Wage Limit

The California Disability Insurance (SDI) wage limit for 2010 increases to \$93,316. Change the "DISABILITY TAX WAGE LIMIT" of the "CA" (California) record of the Tax Data File to 93316.00. (Reference: "2010 California Employer's Guide", DE44MM, p8.)

No Change in the State of California Disability Tax Rate

The California Disability Insurance (SDI) contribution rate for 2010 remains unchanged at 1.1%. Verify that the "DISABILITY EMPLOYEE TAX RATE" is 0.01100; and the "DISABILITY EMPLOYER TAX RATE" is 0.00000. (Reference: "2010 California Employer's Guide", DE44MM, p8.)

No Change in California Deduction for Additional Allowances

The Estimated Deduction for Additional Withholding Allowances remains at \$1,000 per allowance. (Reference: "2010 California Employer's Guide", DE44MM, Table 2, p62.)

New California Withholding Tables

Following this notice are sample screens with the withholding rates for 2010. These changes should be made to the "CA" (California) record of the Tax Parameter File. You must access the Single, Married, and Head of Household) screens individually. (Reference: "2010 California Employer's Guide", DE44MM, Table 5, p63.)

2010 California SDI Tax Rate and Wage Base

The maximum wages subject to California SDI tax increases to \$93,316 for 2010. The Employee SDI withholding rate remains unchanged at 1.1% (.01100).

2010 California Unemployment Employer Tax Rate and Wage Base

The Employer Tax Rate for California Unemployment varies by company. Refer to the Notice of Contribution Rates (Form DE2088) you receive from the California Employment Development Department. To calculate the SUI rate, take your Unemployment Insurance (UI) Contribution and add your Employment Training Tax rate. Take the answer (a percent), change it to decimal form, and put the result in the EMPLOYER TAX RATE field under the column UNEMPLOYMENT. (For example, if your UI Contribution is 3.1% and your Employment Training Tax is 0.1%, your combined rate is 3.2%, and you enter .03200 in the Employer Rate field.) The Unemployment Wage Base remains at \$7000.

2010 California Low Income Exemption

The Low Income Exemption for Singles and Marrieds with 1 or fewer allowances decreases to \$11,130 . . . for Heads of Households and for Marrieds with 2 or more allowances, it decreases to \$22,261. Change the amount for the custom field #1 labeled "S/M1 LIL" to 11130. Change the amount for the custom field #2 labeled "HOH/M2 LIL" to 22261. (Reference: "2010 California Employer's Guide", DE44MM Rev36, Table 1, p62.)

2010 California Standard Deduction

The Standard Deduction for Singles and Marrieds with 1 or fewer allowances decreases to \$3,637 . . . for Heads of Households and for Marrieds with 2 or more allowances, it decreases to \$7,274. Change the amount for the custom field #4 labeled "S/M1STD" to 3637. Change the amount for the custom field #5 labeled "HOH/M2 STD" to 7274.

2010 California Personal Exemption Credit

The Personal Exemption Credit decreases to \$108. Change the amount for the custom field #6 labeled "TAX CREDIT" to 108.
